**OHIO ATHLETIC COMMISSION**

Minutes of the May 14, 2013 meeting of the Ohio Athletic Commission ("OAC") held at 10:00 A.M. at the Bureau of Workers' Compensation, Garfield Heights, Ohio.

- I. The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Executive Director Bernie Profato. Roll call was taken by Executive Director Profato. Present for roll call were: Commissioner Tim Ochsenhirt, Commissioner Dr. Harry Stiggers, Commissioner Robert Schuerger, and Commissioner Jon Stainbrook.
- II. The minutes of the April 16, 2013 meeting were first on the agenda. Commissioner Schuerger moved to approve the minutes. Commissioner Dr. Stiggers seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- III. The Licensure list was presented for Commission approval. Commissioner Schuerger moved to approve the list. Commissioner Dr. Stiggers seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- IV. Under unfinished business, Mr. Profato stated that he presented final budget testimony at the Senate hearing on April 30<sup>th</sup>. The Senate will be making cuts to most budgets with the exception of a few commissions. We should be safe with our budget request.
- V. Under new business, Mr. Profato stated that next month there will be a hearing for Bryan Gonzalez. We received a call that this individual was a registered sex offender. We pulled his license applications and on the last two he marked "no" as a response to the question "Have you ever been convicted of a crime other than a traffic offense?" In this instance we can immediately suspend him for falsification. He did receive our certified letter. There may also be a hearing next month for Brandon Saling to get his license reinstated after fourteen months.
- VI. A Pro Am MMA event in Cleveland on June 1, promoted by Greg Kalikas; Commissioner Dr. Stiggers moved to approve the event. Commissioner Schuerger seconded it and it was unanimously approved.

A Pro Am MMA event in Columbus on June 1, promoted by Tamara MacLaren and Bob Lorimer; Commissioner Dr. Stiggers moved to approve the event. Commissioner Stainbrook seconded it and it was unanimously approved.

- VI. The Executive Director's report was read by all of the Commissioners.
- VII. There were no public comments.
- VIII. Commissioner Dr. Stiggers moved to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Stainbrook seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.
